Mini Contracts

a Approval of Agreements Between Sachem Central School District and Special Education Providers for the 611 and 619 Grants

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Tripi, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreements for receipt of IDEA Flow-Through Funding between Sachem Central School District and Bilinguals Inc./Child & Parent Services as special education providers for the 611 and 619 grants. The costs associated are in accordance with the IDEA section 611 and section 619 federal funds consistent with federal and state statutes. The term of these agreements shall be September 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 for a ten (10) month

program or July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 for a twelve (12) month program. These contracts have been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

b <u>Approval of Agreement Between Sachem Central School District and Cobalt Studios</u> <u>Backdrop Rental</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Tripi, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Cobalt Studios Backdrop Rental for backdrop rental for Sachem High School North's production of Beauty and the Beast. The cost of \$1,444.95 will be paid by the Sachem High School North Drama Club.

Approval of Donation - Lake Grove Lions Club

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Duncan, seconded by Mr. LaCarrubba, and carried unanimously (9-0) to accept with gratitude, the donation of \$1,100.00 from the Lake Grove Lions Club to purchase Wal-Mart gift cards in the amount of \$25.00 per gift card. A total of forty-four (44) gift cards will be sent to Sachem North High School, Samoset Middle School, Gatelot, Cayuga and Wenonah Elementary Schools to be distributed to families in need as determined by school nurses and social workers.

Approval of Purchase for Student Reporting Use

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Duncan seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the purchase of a configurable HP ProLiant DL 180 G6 Server with Quad-core Intel Xeon Processor E5620 to be used for student reporting. The cost of this server is \$13,325.36 to be purchased from the New York State contract.

Approval of DEDUCT Change Order - Valco, Inc. - Samoset Middle School

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve a deduct Change Order No. 1, Valco, Inc. for Samoset Middle School. The original contract amount of \$301,800.00 will be decreased by \$10,000.00 because during the reconstruction work at the chimney, and after the face brick was removed, it was determined that the inner wythes of brick were extensively damaged and reinstalling new face brick, as specified, would not provide a long term solution. Since the cost of the new repairs would be expensive, the District elected to get a credit from the contractor to not install the face brick and stabilize and tarp the chimney until the project could be rebid at a later date and with a new scope of work. The contractor offered a \$10,000.00 credit. The new contract amount including this Change Order will be \$291,800.00.

Approval for LJR Transportation and Mapping to Update District Map

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Isernia, seconded by Ms. Lampitelli, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the request to hire LJR Transportation and Mapping to update the existing school district map which is over ten years old. The new map will show all new streets, street names, schools, and house numbers. The approximate cost of \$8,000 will include the following:

Approval of Payment for Refreshments – Shenandehowa School District Visitation

The unlimited tutorials allow staff unlimited access to as many of the online tutorials and any new tutorials developed during the license period for a complete 12 months. Currently GCN has over 80 tutorials available. The cost of this unlimited tutorials package is \$1,400 and will be covered under the Title IIA Grant.

Approval of INCIRCLE Insurance Agency - Community Education Program Student Accident **Liability Insurance**
