This includes two days in December 2008 to sign up students and faculty, videotape auditions of students and faculty, rehearsal of all the contestants and production of the entire event. The term of this agreement is December 1, 2008 to January 10, 2009. The cost for this event is sixty % of the ticket proceeds from the main event on January 9, 2009. This contract was reviewed and approved by our attorney.”
